To reduce workplace injuries and fatalities, we must understand when, why and how they happen. Having this data on hand will allow businesses in hazardous industries to target problem areas and initiate solutions to reduce workplace accidents.

The Educational Services sector is comprised of establishments that provide instruction and training in a wide variety of subjects. This instruction and training is provided by specialized establishments, such as schools, colleges, universities and training centers. These establishments may be privately owned and operated for profit or not for profit, or they may be publicly owned and operated.

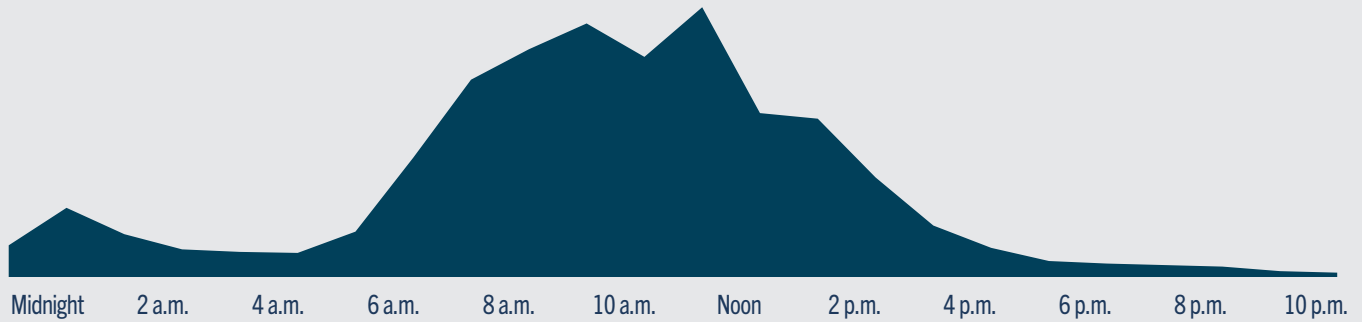

Most Educational Services incidents occurred during the Noon hour.



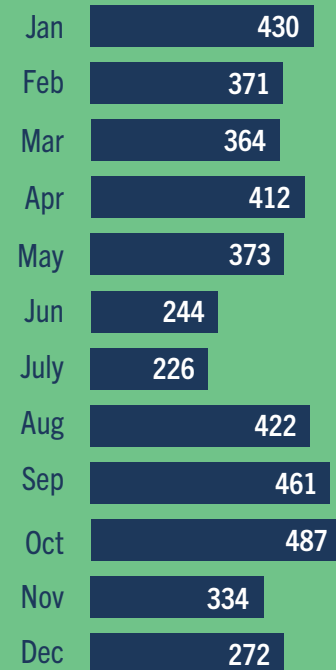
INJURY INCIDENTS BY DAY OF THE WEEK

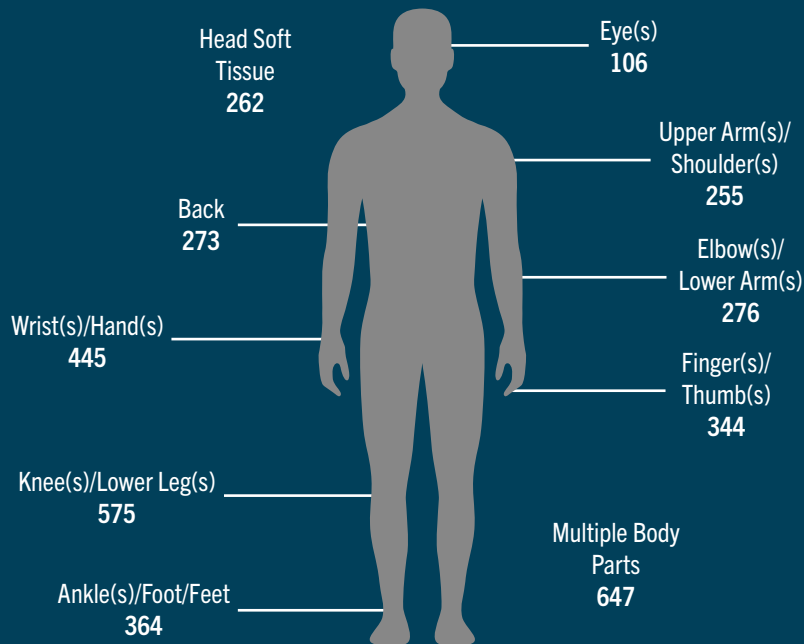
INJURY INCIDENTS BY MONTH

Most Educational Services injury incidents occurred in October.



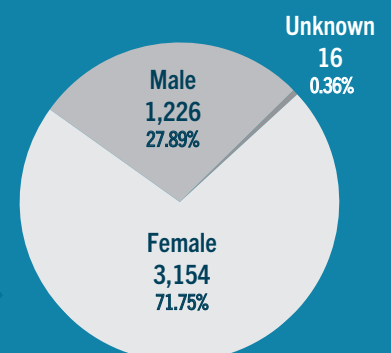
TOP 10 INJURY INCIDENTS BY BODY PART

In Educational Services, females had over two times more incidents than males.



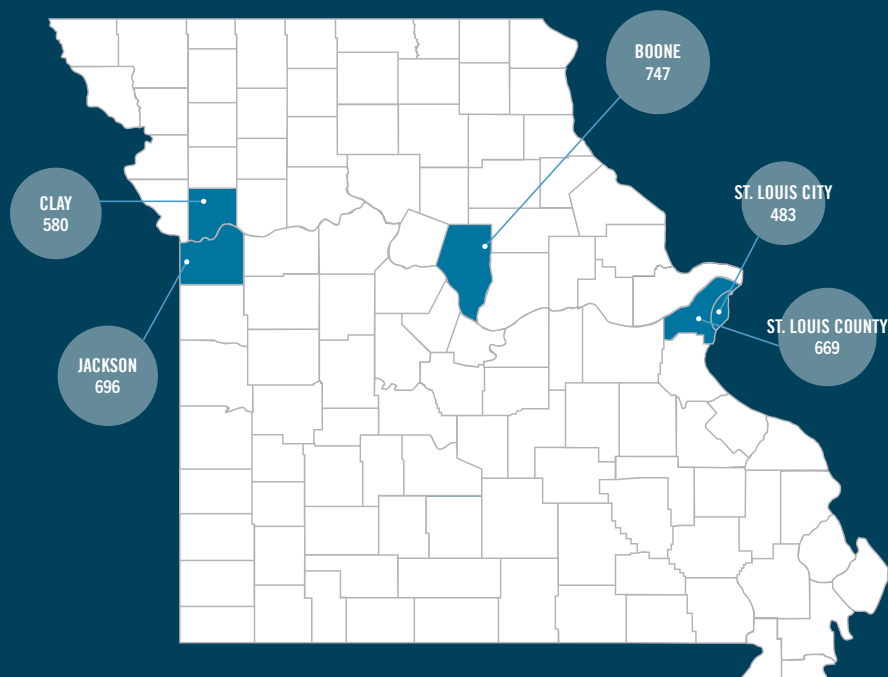
INCIDENTS BY AGE GROUP
