

Most Educational Services incidents occured during the Noon hour.




#### INJURY INCIDENTS BY DAY OF THE WEEK


#### TOP 10 INJURY INCIDENTS BY BODY PART

INJURY INCIDENTS BY MONTH Most Educational Services injury incidents occured in October.








INJURY INCIDENTS BY GENDER
