**PROPOSED RESCISSION**

**8 CSR 60-2.085 Disclosure of Information in Case Files at Hearing Stage.** This rule identified what information may have been disclosed and what information may not have been disclosed.

*PRIVATE COST: This proposed rescission will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.*
