**OBJECTION**


COMES NOW Objector and files its Objection to Annual Wage Order No. 23,  
and states as follows:

1. Annual Wage Order 23 currently sets an open shop rate for wages with 168 hours at \$20.00 hourly wages and \$0.00 fringes in Bates County, Missouri.
2. In Bates County, this is the only reference to the occupational title of CARPENTER.
3. The Carpenters contract with its Union Contractor "Total Interiors" has reported hours in Bates County greater than the Wage Order No. 23 Bates County Carpenter occupational amount by far with the attached submission 2,039 hours as per the attachment with a basic hourly rate of \$32.00 and fringes of H&W \$6.80, Pension \$8.25, CITF .10 cents App.Tr. 40 cents and IAF .20 cents for a total of \$15.75 in fringes for a total wage package of \$47.95.
4. This work covers 29 employees at the Building Rate.

5. Currently, the other Carpenter entities in Bates County are set by the Carpenters Union Collective Bargaining Rates under the classification of Floor Layer, Millwright, and Lather, along with the union rates also for Heavy and Highway at the union rate.
