OBJECTIONS

COMES NOW Objector, by and through undersigned counsel, and files these Objections to Annual Wage Order No. 26, and states as follows:

Objections to Building Rates

With respect to the below-enumerated counties and Occupational Titles, Objector avers that, based on information and belief, the Division of Labor Standards may have failed to account for all of the man-hours worked under Objector's Collective Bargaining Agreement during the relevant time frame. Therefore, Objector herein identifies the number of man-hours and respective Occupational Titles, below, so that the Commission can properly determine whether all applicable hours have been duly accounted for and reflected in the Annual Wage Order.

1. Atchison County Building—AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$18.37. Objector has evidence of 750.5 Carpenter hours @ \$50.42 total package, 623 Linoleum Layer hours @ \$53.61 total package, and 26 Millwright hours @ \$50.42 total package.
2. Camden County Building---AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$42.45. Objector has evidence of 1,909.50 Carpenter hours @ \$43.25 total package.
3. Cass County Building--- AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$55.82. Objector has evidence of 9,968 Carpenter hours @ \$55.92 total package.

4. Cooper County Building---AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$19.07. Objector has evidence of 1,979 Carpenter hours @ \$43.25 total package.
5. Daviess County Building--- AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$16.30. Objector has evidence of 2,224 Carpenter hours @ \$51.28 total package.
6. Jackson County Building--- AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$55.90. Objector has evidence of 12,136 Carpenter hours @ \$55.95 total package.
7. Jefferson County Building---AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$54.69. Objector has evidence of 15,963.50 Carpenter hours @ \$55.95 total package.
8. Laclede County Building--- AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$42.27. Objector has evidence of 3,814 Carpenter hours @ \$42.33 total package.
9. Lafayette County Building--- AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$18.69. Objector has evidence of 1,178 Linoleum Layer hours @ \$53.61 total package.
10. Mercer County Building--- AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$51.28. Objector has evidence of 471 Linoleum Layer hours @ \$53.61 total package.
11. Montgomery County Building---AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$20.06. We will have 16,816 Inside Wireman Electrician hours @ \$55.52 total package.
12. Newton County Building--- AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$37.33. Objector has evidence of 3,033.75 Carpenter hours @ \$41.91 total package.
13. Platte County Building--- AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$55.78. Objector has evidence of 20,438.25 Carpenter hours @ \$55.95 total package.
14. Polk County Building--- AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$20.07. Objector has evidence of 757 Carpenter hours @ \$42.33 total package and 264.5 Linoleum Layer hours @ \$42.23 total package.

15. Ray County Building--- AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$55.13. Objector has evidence of 3,779 Carpenter hours @ \$55.95 total package.
16. St. Charles County Building--- AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$55.56. Objector has evidence of 31,013 Carpenter hours @ \$55.95 total package.
17. St. Louis County Building---AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$55.75. Objector has evidence of 29,443.50 Carpenter hours @ \$55.95 total package.
18. Warren County Building---AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$55.57. Objector has evidence of 3,895.68 Carpenter hours @ \$55.95 total package.
19. Washington County Building---AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$17.23. Objector has evidence of 5,393 Carpenter hours @ \$50.61 total package.
20. Wayne County Building---AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$43.74. Objector has evidence of 2,110 Carpenter hours @ \$44.17 total package.

Objections to Heavy & Highway Rates

With respect to the below-enumerated counties and Occupational Titles, Objector avers that, based on information and belief, the Division of Labor Standards may have failed to account for all of the man-hours worked under Objector's Collective Bargaining Agreement during the relevant time frame. Therefore, Objector herein identifies the number of man-hours and respective Occupational Titles, below, so that the Commission can properly determine whether all applicable hours have been duly accounted for and reflected in the Annual Wage Order.

1. Osage County Heavy & Highway---AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$20.72. Objector has evidence of 474.50 Carpenter hours @ \$48.83 total package.

2. McDonald County Heavy & Highway Rates---AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$20.51. Objector has evidence of 3,301.01 Carpenter hours @ \$46.95 total package.

3. Stoddard County Heavy & Highway Rates---AWO #26 wages and benefits for total package currently set at \$21.03. Objector has evidence of 4,160 Carpenter hours @ \$48.69 total package.

WHEREFORE, Objector respectfully requests that the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission consider favorably the Objections of Objector and revise the basic hourly wage rate in the aforementioned counties under the aforementioned Occupational Titles, as described herein, to reflect the prevailing practices throughout the geographic jurisdiction in question, and for such other changes as are deemed appropriate.
