

ORDER OF COMMISSION

In Re: Motion to Amend General Wage Order No. 58 filed by the Division of Labor Standards, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations

On July 31, 2014, the Division of Labor Standards (Division) filed a Motion to Amend General Wage Order No. 58 with the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission (Commission). General Wage Order No. 58 was previously filed on June 30, 2014, with the Secretary of State's Office.

The Division alleges that it discovered typographical, grammatical, or clerical errors subsequent to filing of the general wage order with the Missouri Secretary of State's Office on June 30, 2014. The Division notes that the space designated for the basic hourly rate payable to General Laborers in Warren County in General Wage Order No. 58 is blank. The Division alleges that this was the product of an inadvertent error, and that the rate should be \$29.93 per hour.

The Division has attached to the Motion the corrected page sought to replace that previously filed with the Secretary of State's Office. The Division requests that the Commission enter an order to substitute the designated replacement page for the page currently found in General Wage Order No. 58, along with any other relief to which the Division may be entitled.

The Motion to Amend General Wage Order No. 58 was posted to the Commission's website on August 7, 2014. No objections have been filed to the Division's Motion to Amend. Having received no objections, the Commission sustains the Motion to Amend General Wage Order No. 58, filed by the Division on July 31, 2014.


