

ORDER OF COMMISSION

In Re: Motion to Amend Annual Wage Order No. 22 filed by the Division of Labor Standards, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations.

On March 27, 2015, a Motion to Amend Annual Wage Order No. 22 (Motion) was filed by the Division of Labor Standards (Division) with the Commission. On March 30, 2015, the Division filed a Supplement To Motion To Amend Annual Wage Order No. 22. On April 17, 2015, the Commission issued an order granting, in part, the Division's Motion to Amend, but reserving a ruling with respect to certain of the Division's requested changes in light of objections to Annual Wage Order No. 22 that were then pending before the Commission.

Specifically, we held that we could not accept the changes reflected in the replacement pages submitted by the Division for the counties of Butler, Caldwell (heavy construction rates), Chariton (heavy construction rates), Crawford, Howard, Howell (heavy construction rates), Laclede, Madison, Maries (heavy construction rates), Montgomery (heavy construction rates), New Madrid, Osage, Pemiscot, Pike (heavy construction rates), Pulaski (heavy construction rates), Reynolds, Ripley (both building as well as heavy construction rates), St. Francois (heavy construction rates), Scotland, Shannon, Stoddard, Warren (heavy construction rates), Washington (heavy construction rates), and Wayne, because there were pending objections that either directly conflicted with the changes sought by the Division, or implicated rates and schedules set forth on the replacement pages the Division sought to substitute for the originals.

As of May 11, 2015, the objections to Annual Wage Order No. 22 had all been resolved by agreement of the parties. Those objections resolved any issues with respect to the appropriate rates and schedules for the classifications of Millwright in Scotland County; Carpenter (heavy construction rates) in the counties of Howell, Maries, Montgomery, Pike, Pulaski, Ripley, St. Francois, Warren, and Washington; Painter in the counties of New Madrid, Pemiscot, Ripley, and Wayne; and Glazier in Reynolds County. No objections have been filed to the remainder of the changes sought by the Division in its Motion to Amend. Accordingly, we hereby take up the remainder of the Division's Motion to Amend.

Because no objections have been filed to the remainder of the changes sought by the Division in its Motion to Amend, and because the Commission accepts the stated purpose of the Motion to Amend to correct inadvertent typographical or clerical errors on the part of the Division, the Commission hereby accepts the rates and schedules set forth in the replacement pages attached to the Division's Motion to Amend with respect to the counties of Butler, Caldwell (heavy construction rates), Chariton (heavy construction rates), Crawford, Howard, Laclede, Madison, Osage, Scotland, Shannon,

and Stoddard. Specifically, the Commission orders that Annual Wage Order No. 22 be changed to reflect the following corrected rates and schedules:

Accordingly, we discern no reason to order a change to Annual Wage order No. 22 with respect to the appropriate footnote page for Elevator Constructor in Howard County.




