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
Re: Carpenters' Prevailing Wage Objection for Marion County.

Dear Sir or Madam:

I represent the Carpenters' District Council of Greater St. Louis. On April 1, 2009, the District Council submitted a prevailing wage objection to the carpenter classification for Marion County. That objection attached two Contractors Reports: Exhibit A was hours from Behlman Builders, Inc. and Exhibit B was hours from Acme Interiors. The District Council hereby withdraws Exhibit A and requests that only Exhibit B be used to determine the prevailing wages and benefits for Marion County.

The objection also attached the collective bargaining agreement between the District Council and the Tri-County Builders Association as Exhibit C. This agreement was attached to show that the proper overtime and holiday schedules for Marion County are Overtime Schedule No. 79 and Holiday Schedule No. 42. For further clarification, the hours submitted by Acme Interiors in Exhibit B were paid pursuant to the wage and benefit scale in the Tri-County Agreement. Therefore, the overtime and holiday schedules contained in that agreement (No. 79 and 42, respectively) should control in Marion County.
