

ORDER OF COMMISSION

In Re: Motion to Clarify General Wage Order No. 55 filed by the Division of Labor Standards, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations.

On July 13, 2011, a Motion to Clarify General Wage Order No. 55 was filed by the Division of Labor Standards with the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission (Commission) for the Commission's consideration and action. General Wage Order No. 55 had previously been filed on June 30, 2011, with the Secretary of State's Office.

The Motion to Clarify General Wage Order No. 55 was posted on the Commission's website on July 14, 2011. The Motion indicated that after the filing of General Wage Order No. 55, the Division of Labor Standards realized that on some projects work is performed that falls within occupational title(s) that are not listed on General Wage Order No. 55. The clarification is necessary to notify affected parties where to obtain the proper wage rate for the respective occupational title(s) that are not otherwise listed on General Wage Order No. 55. Attached to the Motion was a page with clarifying language sought to replace the original designated page filed with the Secretary of State's Office. The Motion requests that the Commission enter an order to substitute the designated page attached for the original page found in General Wage Order No. 55, along with any other relief that the Commission deems appropriate.

No objections have been filed to the Division's Motion to Clarify. Having received no objections, the Commission sustains the Motion to Clarify General Wage Order No. 55, originally filed by the Division of Labor Standards on July 13, 2011.






