MOTION TO AMEND GENERAL WAGE ORDER NO. 55


COMES NOW the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Standards, ("Movant" and/or "Division of Labor Standards") and makes this motion to amend General Wage Order No. 55 to correct typographical, clerical, and grammatical errors.

Movant would show the Commission as follows:

1. On June 30, 2011, the Division of Labor Standards filed General Wage Order No. 55 with the Secretary of State. General Wage Order No. 55 sets forth by county the initial wage rate determination for the occupational titles involved in the construction of public works projects for the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission.
2. After the filing of General Wage Order No. 55, the Division of Labor Standards discovered typographical, grammatical and clerical errors in General Wage Order No. 55.
3. The corrections detailed in the attached pages are necessary to accurately reflect the information that was on file at the Division of Labor Standards prior to June 30, 2011, and to identify the proper wage rate for the occupational titles.
4. The Division of Labor Standards requests that the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission substitute the attached 1 page for the original page in the general wage order. On the attached page the correction or addition is identified by bold print.
5. Public policy is served by making the attached corrections to reflect the proper wage rates.

WHEREFORE, the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Standards, requests that the Commission enter an order to substitute the attached 1 page for the original page in General Wage Order No. 55 and grant any and all other relief to which it may be entitled.
