Dear Sir:

Upon review, it has been determined that certain information provided with respect to the Occupational Title of "Ironworker" in Osage County, Missouri, was incorrect. Specifically, the Contractor's Reports of Construction Wage Rates listed an incorrect total fringe benefit package for Osage County. The correct package should be as follows:

- Welfare - \$6.36;
- Pension - \$6.95;
- Annuity - \$4.30;
- Apprenticeship Training - \$0.40;
- IMPACT - \$0.24; and
- CISAP - \$0.05,

for a total of \$18.30 per hour in fringe benefits.
