ANNUAL WAGE ORDER NO. 19

MOTION TO AMEND ANNUAL WAGE ORDER NO. 19

COMES NOW the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Standards, and respectfully submits this motion to amend Annual Wage Order No. 19 to correct typographical, clerical, and grammatical errors. In support of this Motion, the Division of Labor Standards states as follows:

1. On March 9, 2012, the Division of Labor Standards filed Annual Wage Order No. 19 with the Secretary of State. Annual Wage Order No. 19 sets forth by county the initial wage rate determination for the occupational titles involved in the construction of public works projects.
2. After the filing of Annual Wage Order No. 19 the Division of Labor Standards discovered typographical, grammatical and clerical errors in the Order.
3. The corrections detailed in the attached pages are necessary to accurately reflect the information that was on file at the Division of Labor Standards prior to March 9, 2012.
4. The Division of Labor Standards requests that the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission substitute the attached ten pages for the original pages in the Annual Wage Order. On each of the attached pages the correction or addition is identified by bold print. Additionally, the Occupational Title and rates of Skilled Labor on the Heavy Construction Rate Sheet for Lincoln, Montgomery, St. Charles, City of St. Louis, St. Louis and Warren Counties have been deleted and those deletions are indicated by strike-throughs on the attached pages.
5. Public policy is served by making the attached corrections to reflect the proper wage rates.

WHEREFORE, the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Standards, respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order to substitute the attached ten pages for the original pages in Annual Wage Order No. 19 and grant any and all other relief to which it may be entitled.
