Prevailing Wage /Carpenters-Ozark County, Missouri

Dear Sir/Madame:

The undersigned and this law firm represent the St. Louis District Council of Greater St. Louis and Vicinity ("Carpenters"). The Carpenters represent all union carpenters in the State of Missouri.

This is an Appeal of the prevailing wage set for persons performing carpentry work in Ozark County. **PLEASE DISREGARD THE PRIOR APPEAL FOR OSAGE COUNTY.**

The prevailing wage for Carpenters in Ozark County, Missouri was set on March 10, 2012 by General Wage Order 19 at \$15.50 per hour with no fringe benefits and overtime at time and one half over 40 hours in a week.

The Carpenters have evidence that a majority of the work performed by persons doing carpenter's work in Ozark County was performed at the rates set forth on the attached wage sheet.

I trust that these documents conform to the requirements for establishing an appeal of the prevailing wage for carpenters in Ozark County and that a hearing will be set to address this Appeal.


