ORDER OF COMMISSIONSECRETARY OF STATE

In the matter of Objection No. 239 filed by Local No. 396, International Association of Bridge, Structural, Ornamental and Reinforcing Ironworkers of St. Louis and Vicinity, AFL-CIO (Objector) on April 6, 2012, to Annual Wage Order No. 19, pertaining to the building construction wage rate, total fringe benefit, and the overtime and holiday schedules for the occupational title of Ironworker in the Missouri County of Shannon – Section 105, issued by the Division of Labor Standards, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations; filed with the Secretary of State: March 9, 2012.


On April 6, 2012, objection to Annual Wage Order No. 19 filed on behalf of Local No. 396, International Association of Bridge, Structural, Ornamental and Reinforcing Ironworkers of St. Louis and Vicinity, AFL-CIO (Objector), was received by the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission ("Commission"). A prehearing in this matter was held on May 15, 2012, and a hearing had been set for June 4, 2012, and June 5, 2012 (if necessary).

The Commission has subsequently received a request from Objector to allow it to withdraw its objection. The Commission grants Objector's request to withdraw Objection No. 239.


The Commission will not issue an order regarding the objection to Annual Wage Order No. 19.
