2.       Iron Workers Local #10 represents individuals who perform construction work within more than fifty (50) counties in the State of Missouri under the Occupational Title of “Ironworker” under 8 C.S.R. § 30-3.060.
3.       The Glaziers, Architectural, Metal and Glass Workers Local Union No. 513 (“Glaziers Local 513”) has filed Objection No. 068-182 seeking amendments to the existing work description for the Occupational Titles of “Glazier” and “Ironworker” under 8 C.S.R. § 30-3.060.
4.       Ironworkers Local #10 has a presumptive interest in this Objection since Glaziers Local 513 is seeking to delete a portion of the existing Occupational Title of “Ironworker”.


