

ORDER OF COMMISSION

In Re: Second Motion to Amend Annual Wage Order No. 20 filed by the Division of Labor Standards, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations.

On April 3, 2013, a Second Motion to Amend Annual Wage Order No. 20 was filed by the Division of Labor Standards (Division) with the Commission. Also on April 3, 2013, a Request for Substitution was filed by the Division wherein the Division formally withdrew its initial Motion to Amend General Wage Order No. 20 filed on March 22, 2013, and requested that the Commission instead consider the Division's Second Motion to Amend Annual Wage Order No. 20.

The Second Motion to Amend Annual Wage Order No. 20 indicates its purpose is to correct typographical, grammatical, and clerical errors discovered by the Division of Labor Standards subsequent to the filing of the wage order with the Secretary of State's Office. Attached to the Motion are 107 pages the Division seeks to replace in the Annual Wage Order No. 20 filed with the Secretary of State's Office. The Motion requests that the Commission enter an order to substitute the designated pages attached for the original pages found in Annual Wage Order No. 20, along with any other relief that the Commission deems appropriate.

The Second Motion to Amend Annual Wage Order No. 20 filed April 3, 2013, was promptly posted on the Commission's website. No objections have been filed to the Motion. Having received no objections, the Commission sustains the Second Motion to Amend Annual Wage Order No. 20, filed by the Division of Labor Standards on April 3, 2013.
