Below is a summary of events that led to inaccurate information from the AWO application.

Thank you,

Division of Labor Standards (DLS) uses a web application, Annual Wage Order (AWO), to collect labor rates from employers. Around the 2012 timeframe, a data input field within the AWO was modified to collect alphabetical data instead of numeric data. DLS reporting requirements for AWO data changed with 2014 legislation requiring the system to report on the previous 6 years. Because of the 2012 change to the AWO data field, the reporting on the previous 6 years was not valid. In an effort to resolve the reporting error, in January 2015, the data field within AWO was changed back to numeric data. The change was completed on the test AWO server and the report was validated by DLS staff. Steps were performed to update production AWO data and DLS was informed of completion, however, the update to the production AWO server did not complete successfully. DLS staff were to perform validation that the production AWO report was accurate. It has been recently discovered that the AWO report DLS produced on March 10, 2015 did not contain accurate information for 2013.
