ANNUAL WAGE ORDER NO. 31

**MOTION TO AMEND ANNUAL WAGE ORDER NO. 31**

COMES NOW the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Standards, and respectfully submits this motion to amend Annual Wage Order No. 31. In support of its Motion, the Division of Labor Standards (“Division”) states as follows:

1. On March 8, 2024, the Division filed Annual Wage Order No. 31 with the Secretary of State. Annual Wage Order No. 31 sets forth by county the initial wage rate determination for the occupational titles involved in the construction of public works projects.

2. After the filing of Annual Wage Order No. 31, the Division discovered clerical errors.

These errors affected the rate sheets for Pettis County:

- a. A clerical error was discovered in the building construction rate, prevailing hourly rate for Painter in Pettis County; the rate was erroneously issued as \$42.22, but the correct hourly rate is \$41.49, resulting in a decrease in the hourly rate of \$0.73;

These errors affected the rate sheets for Phelps County:

- a. A clerical error was discovered in the building construction rate, prevailing hourly rate for Painter in Phelps County; the rate was erroneously issued as

\$48.19, but the correct hourly rate is \$48.22, resulting in an increase in the hourly rate of \$0.03;

These errors affected the rate sheets for Warren County:

a. A clerical error was discovered in the building construction rate, prevailing hourly rate for Iron Worker in Warren County; the rate was erroneously issued as \$70.48, but the correct hourly rate is \$70.49, resulting in an increase in the hourly rate of \$0.01;

These errors affected the rate sheets for Washington County:

a. A clerical error was discovered in the building construction rate, prevailing hourly rate for Iron Worker in Washington County; the rate was erroneously issued as \$71.73, but the correct hourly rate is \$71.26, resulting in a decrease in the hourly rate of \$0.47;

3. These clerical errors were discovered after business agents contacted the Division to determine what hours were used to set the rates or if a specific contractor submitted hours;

4. The corrections, detailed both above and in the attached pages, are necessary to accurately reflect the information that was on file with the Division prior to March 8, 2024.


5. The Division requests that the Commission substitute the attached pages for the original pages in the Annual Wage Order (bold print on this page identifies the corrections to be made);

6. Public policy is served by making the attached corrections to reflect the proper wage rates.

WHEREFORE, the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Standards, respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order to substitute the

attached 4 pages for the original page(s) in Annual Wage Order No. 31 and grant any and all other relief to which it may be entitled.
